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- Minimum of a Masters level degree from accredited institution in health/behavioral science field, or equivalent, at International university
- Appropriate documentation/certification/licensure as required by country in which applicant lives in order to treat individuals with eating and associated disorders
- Behavioral Component (courses completed in following topic areas or similar):
 - Gender issues, women's studies, multicultural issues, human sexuality
 - Human development
 - Abnormal psychology, addictions
- Skills Component (courses completed in following topic areas or similar):
 - Individual psychotherapy Group psychotherapy Family psychotherapy
- One course in professional practice standards and ethics
- Seminar providing minimum of 6 CEUs focusing on body image, weight and food issues
- Complete **iaedp**™ core courses (or equivalent approved by the Certification Director/Committee)
 - Introduction to Eating Disorders Treatment Modalities of Eating Disorders
 - Medical/Physiological Aspects of Eating Disorders Nutrition/Dietetics and Weight Management
 - 2500 word Case Study (must be of patient actually treated by the applicant)
- Pass **iaedp**™ Certification Exam
- 2000 direct ED Patient Hours—Supervision with iaedp™ Approved Supervisor
- Statement of Intent
- Signed Ethics Statement (APA Guidelines)
- Completed application with (1) passport photo and Application Fee (\$150.00)
