	Can start accruing hours when: - Medical Providers: Beginning of residency.
	Accrues 2500 hours of eating disorder experience under supervision of an iaedp-Approved Supervisor (iaedp-Approved Supervisor completes supervision section of application) - No less than 2 years
	- 75% of supervision must be within your own discipline (therapist and therapists, medical providers and medical providers, RDs and RDs), 25% can be with a different discipline
	- Minimum 24 hours of supervision (Supervision can be 100% group, 100% individual/dyad, or any combination of individual/dyad and group)
	 80% direct hours (Direct Client Service: activities directly related to treatment of client/patient including face-to-face interaction, case conceptualization, team coordination of care, and treatment documentation. Indirect hours include: presentations, case-based learning/teaching, program development, coursework and readings, blog entrie and other writing, etc.)
	Completes Questions within Application (statement of intent, treatment approach, disclosures, and ethics)
	Member of iaedp (paid and current in regards to your dues)
	Completes 4 Core Course + Tests
	 Core Courses can count for CE requirement as well if they have been completed in the past 2 years of application submission
	Takes Final Exam
	 Examples of the subject matter that is related to Eating Disorders include, but are not necessarily limited to: psychotherapy techniques that can be applied to those suffering from eating disorders; psychological disorders common in persons with eating disorders, such as child sexual abuse, depression, obsessive compulsive disorder, substance dependence, etc; physical problems commonly seen in persons with eating disorders, including obesity, malnutrition, dental problems, medical problems present with persons with eating disorders, etc. and similar topics. Doctoral or master level courses and publications do not count as CEs.

	Proof of license - must be active and current (need expiration date)
	 Must be fully and independently licensed at time of submitting application

A certification renewal late fee of \$125 will be incurred at 30 days past the expiration date. If a member fails to renew within 90 days of expiration date, the certification will be revoked. The member will be required to complete a new Certification application.
